## 1- Kowloon Mosque and Islamic Centre.



## **Description:**

One of Hong Kong's five main mosques is the Kowloon Masjid and Islamic Centre, also known as the Kowloon Mosque. The largest mosque in Hong Kong is currently located in Kowloon, in the Tsim Sha Tsui neighbourhood, The mosque can hold up to 3,500 people for each of the five daily prayers.



This mosque is decorated and ornated with traditional Muslim design stood out in contrast to the logical and contemporary architecture of the neighbouring office buildings. The four 11-meter-tall minarets that mark the corners of the upper terrace and the widespread use of white marble on the paving and the facade are the building's most noticeable elements.

A medical centre and a library are also available along with three prayer halls and a community hall. One thousand people can fit in the primary prayer hall on the first floor. On the second floor, a smaller prayer room for ladies is located. It is encircled by a patio. A dome with a diameter of 5 meters and a height of 9 meters atop this upper hall.

## **Description:**

Established in 1981, this mosque has a 700-person capacity, and is commonly used by Muslims. The centre features a



kindergarten for the Muslim community on the ground floor, separate wudu facilities for men and women on the first floor, and an air-conditioned mosque with enough for 600 people on the second and third floors.



Lessons in Arabic and the Qur'an are taught in the classroom on the fourth level. The Islamic there is a library and a room for conferences, lectures, and seminars. The general office, a conference room, a meeting room, a clinic, and other spaces are located on the seventh floor. regular Islamic workshops are also held in this Islamic centre. It also offers classes on Quran reading and for Muslims who have just converted to Islam. On certain occasions, school or university students plan their field trips visit the mosque.

## 3- Jamia Masjid/Shelley Street Mosque

## **Description:**

This is Hong Kong's first mosque. The mosque is rectangular in design and has Arabic-style arched windows on each side in addition to an arched main entrance. The pillar was left in place when the mosque was expanded in



1915.Hong Kong's oldest mosque, restored in 1905 after being built in 1890. In May 2010, the Government of Hong Kong designated the structure as a Grade I building, which is defined as having "outstanding merits that every effort should be made to preserve if possible."

#### Description:

Inaugurated On August 4, 1963. The main prayer hall had air conditioners installed, and the entire structure had been refurbished by the Incorporated Trustees of the Islamic Community Fund of Hong Kong in 2005. The Mosque



enjoys a tranquil and peaceful environment and is surrounded by mountains and lush vegetation. There is a large open area outside the prayer room that can accommodate modest religious groups. The mosque received the designation of Grade 3 historic building from the Advisory Board of Antiques and Monuments Office in 2010. There is also a Muslim cemetery.



## **5-** Stanley Mosque

#### **Description:**

The fourth mosque to be constructed in Hong Kong was Stanley Mosque. The mosque was constructed utilizing elements of Islamic, Ottoman, Saracenic, Moorish, Byzantine, and Chinese architecture. It was initially built for the 400 Muslims who worked for the Prison Department during the colonial era.



Since Stanley Masjid is in a restricted location, visitors must acquire permission in advance to visit. Visitors are not permitted to leave the masjid's premises and must remain inside them. The Stanley Masjid also hosts regular Jumma prayers.

## 6- Ibrahim Mosque, Yau Ma Tei

#### **Description:**

It is Hong Kong's sixth and most recent mosque. The mosque contains a number of amenities, including an office for the imam, an ablution room, a pantry, classrooms, and a conference



room. According to religious and cultural values and customs, these are segregated into different groups for men and women. From the Mong Kok station of the MTR's Exit C2, you can walk to the mosque.
